Highway 50 east,

Exit at East Bidwell St./placerville Road. Turn Left.

Follow East Bidwell St./placerville Road approximately 2 miles.

Turn Right on Oak Ave. Parkway.





To Pannell Community Center, 2450 Meadowview Rd., Sacramento:

I-5 to Pocket Road/Meadowview Road exit (east)

(Pocket Road turns into Meadowview at Freeport Blvd.)

Follow Meadowview Road approximately 1.5 miles.

Cross street is 24th Ave.

To South Natomas Community Center, 2921 Truxel Rd., Sacramento:

I-5 to West El Camino Ave.

Go east on West El Camino Ave.

Turn north on Truxel Ave.
