► Developmental Screening Services for Children 0-5 Years Olds in Yolo County

Early identification and support for developmental and behavioral challenges are important for a child's school readiness and lifelong emotional and academic success.

Computer-based questionnaires are available through Davis Developmental Pediatrics Group, Inc. to provide screening of children 0-5 years old who live in Yolo County for early signs of developmental delays, autism, parent - child goodness of fit and emotional regulation.

Each family will receive a report describing each child's strengths and challenges to be shared with their pediatrician. Families will be offered suggestions for available services to help their child with their specific challenges.

Log on to www.chadis.com. New users will need invitation code: 5307583374 to create an account for each child. Complete the assigned questionnaires and call Davis Developmental Pediatrics Group for the report and recommendations!

There is no charge for the report with recommended Yolo county resources.
