### ► **Developmental Screening Services for Children 0-5 Years Olds in Yolo County**

Early identification and support for developmental and behavioral challenges are important for a child's school readiness and lifelong emotional and academic success.

Computer-based questionnaires are available through Davis Developmental Pediatrics Group, Inc. to provide screening of children 0-5 years old who live in Yolo County for early signs of developmental delays, autism, parent-child goodness of fit and emotional regulation.

Each family will receive a report describing each child's strengths and challenges to be shared with their pediatrician. Families will be offered suggestions for available services to help their child with their specific challenges.
